


RPO History

 New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) is the designated
 State Agency that receives
 and administers federal and
 state transportation funds.

>NMDOT created 7 Regional Planning Organizations (RPOs) within the State of New Mexico.



RPO History

> RPO process has been in place since early 1990s.

> NMDOT has contracted with Councils of Governments (COGs) to provide administrative and staff support for the RPOs since 2005.



RPO Structure

> RPOs consist of two Committees: Policy & Technical Committees

Policy & Technical
 Committee members
 are appointed by chief,
 elected officials of local/
 county/tribal
 governments.

RPO Structure

> Policy Committee representatives make policy decisions and serve as the voting member > Technical Committee representatives usually have transportation background and technical expertise

- Workshops and trainings in Summer
- Quorum is 33%
- Participation Requirements
 - Eligible governing body
 - Letter/E-mail from governing body
