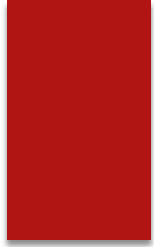

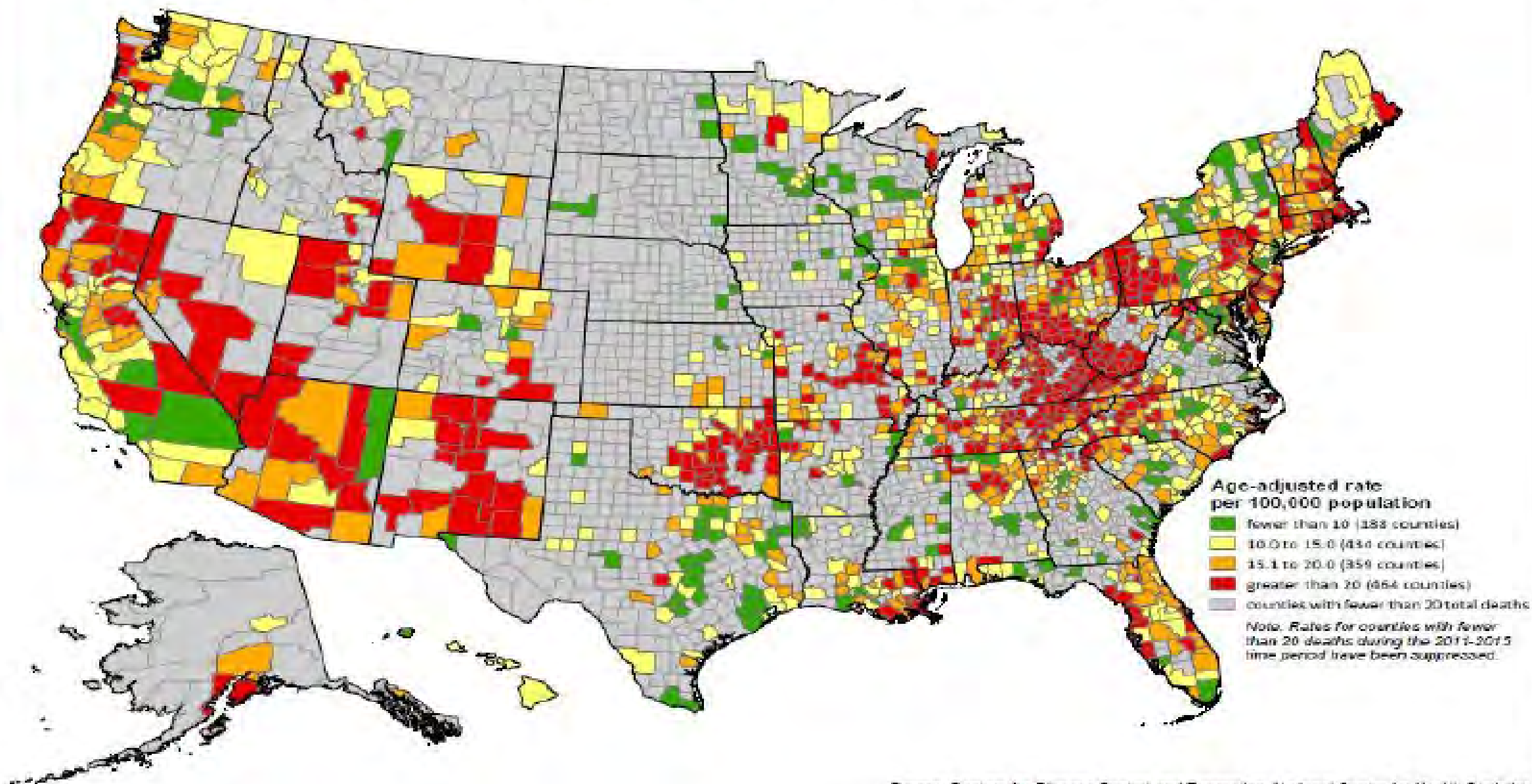






Drug Poisoning Deaths, by County, 2011-2015

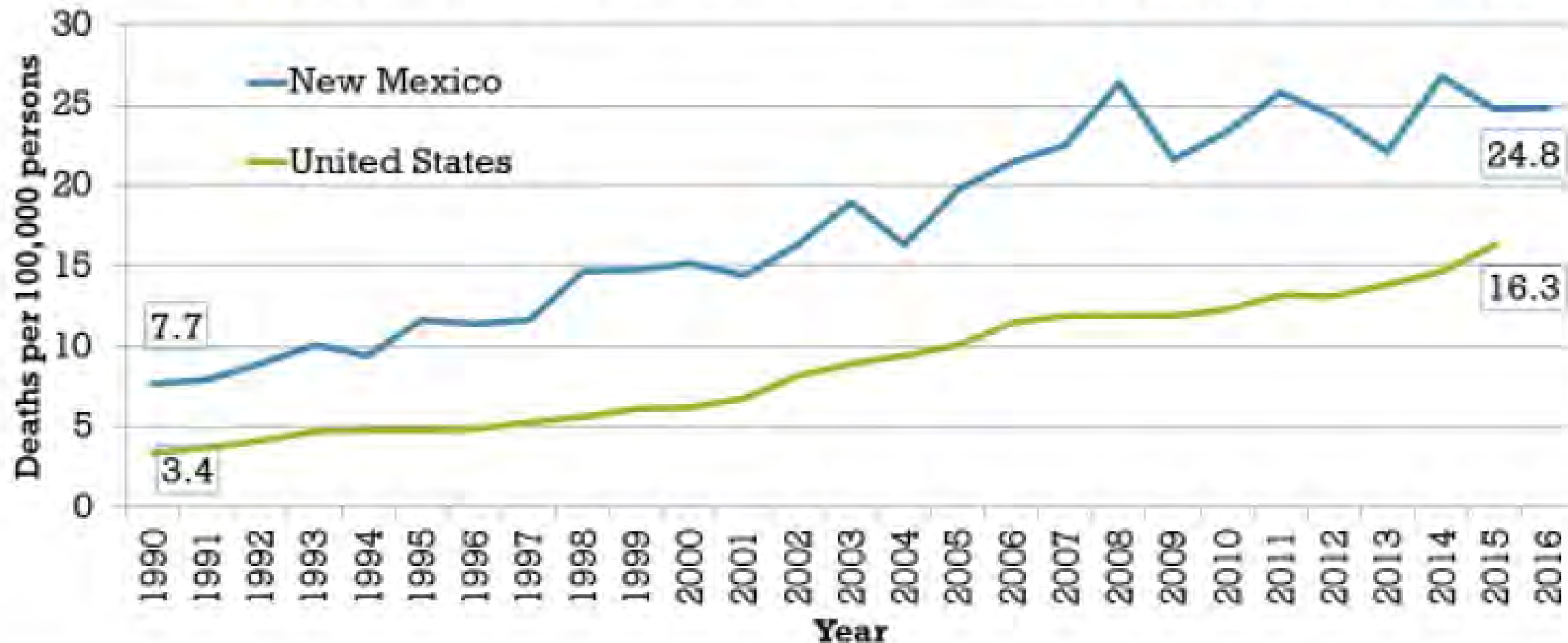
U.S. National Age Adjusted Rate: 14.2 Deaths per 100,000 Population

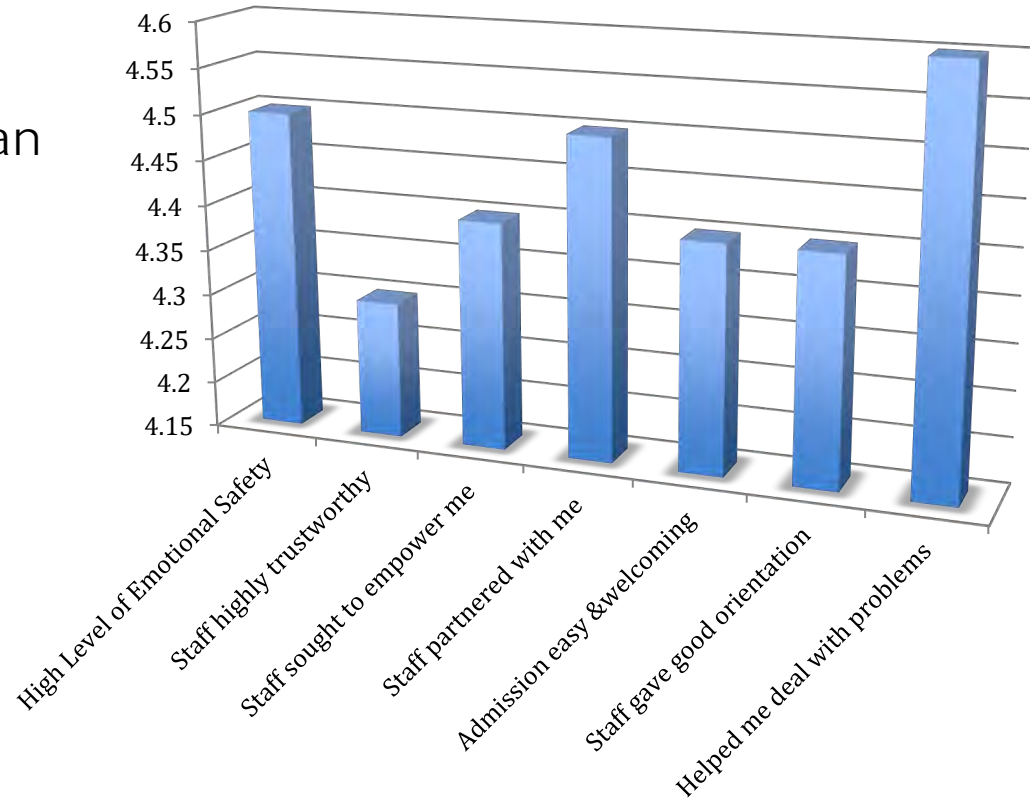
